Meeting Minutes

Date: Monday, December 13th 2021

- 1. Call to Order and Attendance
 - a Meeting called to order at 2:00pm
 - b Commissioners Jeanne Galloway, Greg Lewis, and Carolyn Ness in attendance.

- 2. Public Comment/Output

- 3. Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes (vote required)
 - a A motion to approve the November meeting minutes by Greg was proposed with a second by Carolyn.
 - b Passed 3-0.
- 4. 2021 Mosquito Surveillance Reports
 - a Samples of surveillance reports were provided with the newly included narrative section with notes regarding the 2021 surveillance season. Improvements for next season were considering, primarily making a point to take notes throughout the season for final reports.
 - b Plans to improve bait quality for gravid traps were considered for the 2022 season for more consistent gravid catches.
- 5. Supplemental Funding Discussion
 - a Commissioners discussed the ARPA earmark for the PVMCD. A sum of \$100,000 appears to be coming to the district, contingent on Gov. Baker signing the newly passed ARPA law.
 - b The primary need for the district continues to be a facility, though avenues to procure space with ARPA funding is limited. Trucks would be a second priority to start building a fleet for seasonal staff.

- a The search for a commissioner for the empty fifth seat was discussed. Commissioners were asked to continue searching for a candidate and recommend that they apply.
